## PROPOSED ROAD LAYOUT CHANGE – MARYBANK

Nelson City Council (NCC) have received a number of requests to improve road safety in Marybank. To achieve improved safety, NCC is proposing to make the following changes:

### Tresillian Avenue – Proposed No Stopping

NCC are proposing to install yellow No Stopping lines near Clifton Terrace School to prevent cars parking over driveways and in the shoulder hatching.

### Jackson Street – Proposed No Stopping and Give Way

NCC is proposing to install a Give Way traffic control device on Jackson Street at the intersection with Wastney Terrace and Tresillian Avenue. This would legally require uphill traffic to Give Way. Proposed yellow No Stopping lines would prohibit cars parking within the Give Way intersection.

### Marybank Road – Proposed No Stopping

NCC is proposing to install yellow No Stopping lines on Marybank Road, on two sections of blind corners (toward the intersection with SH6). Currently, parked cars are forcing vehicles into the live lane, causing them to cross the centre line on these corners.
