

## WORKS NOTICE – Flood Protection

- WHAT:** Construction of stopbanks and a flood wall  
**WHERE:** Orphanage Stream banks between Saxton Road East and Suffolk Road  
**WHEN:** Monday 11 January 2021 to April 2021



### WHAT ARE WE DOING?

- Council's contractor (Downer Group Ltd) will be constructing earth stopbanks and a timber floodwall along the banks of Orphanage Stream.

### WHY ARE WE DOING IT?

- To improve flood protection in this area. This work will increase the volume of water the stream can carry, reducing the chance of flooding in a major weather event.

### DURATION:

- Approximately 4 months (Monday 11 January 2021 to April 2021). All work will be undertaken between the hours of 7:30 am to 5:30 pm Monday to Friday.

### PUBLIC ACCESS:

- Sections of the esplanade, including the footpath, will be closed to the public. These areas will be reopened as work progresses.
- We thank you for your patience and ask that you follow the instructions of site staff and signage at all times.
